

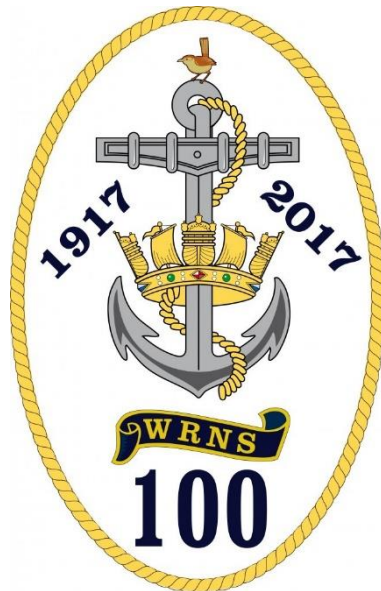
Join the Wrens

The Women's Royal Naval Service (or Wrens) was the women's branch of the Royal Navy and first formed in 1917. During the Second World War, over 1,500 Wrens were trained on HMS Unicorn.

One of the most important skills they learnt was to send and receive Morse code messages. Morse code uses dots-and-dashes instead of letters to communicate.

Can you master Morse code and join the Wrens?

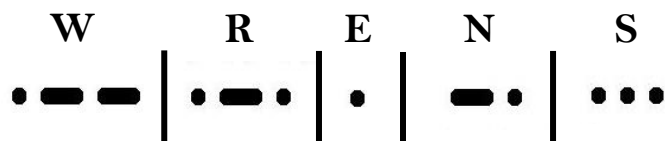
